## **Janssen announces the winners of the 13<sup>th</sup> Heart Calendar Contest 2014** 12 works of excellence and 38 outstanding finalists selected from more than 1,100 entries

Tokyo, Japan, Dec 1, 2014 – Janssen Pharmaceutical K.K. Through this contest, Janssen supports the creative activities of people who are engaged in art as part of their treatment or as a hobby. At the same time, Janssen Japan will continue to support this contest in the future to contribute to creating a society that is free of discrimination and prejudice against mental disabilities and help people with such disabilities to lead a better life.
